


Australia

- TOEFL® scores are accepted for all student visas
- Universities in Australia have been using TOEFL scores for more than 45 years
- Since November 2014, TOEFL scores are accepted for skilled migration, post-study work and permanent resident visas.

The TOEFL® Test Format

Section	Description	Testing Time	Score Scale
Reading	3–4 passages from academic texts; 12–14 questions per passage	60–80 min.	0–30
Listening	4–6 lectures, some with classroom discussion, 6 questions each;2–3 conversations, 5 questions each	60–90 min.	0–30
Break	-	10 min.	-
Speaking	2 tasks to express an opinion; 4 tasks to speak based on reading and listening passages	20 min.	0–30
Writing	1 integrated task (write based on what is read and listened to); 1 independent task (support an opinion on a topic)	50 min.	0–30
Total	-	-	0–120

Note taking is allowed in all sections.

Scoring Sets the *TOEFL®* **Test Apart**

Scoring process ensures fairness and integrity

- Rigorous rater training
- Daily calibration for Speaking and Writing raters
- Multiple raters for Speaking and Writing
 - 3 to 6 raters for Speaking responses
 - 4 ratings for Writing responses
- Scoring is separate from the testing site to maintain score integrity
 - Raters see and hear worldwide responses, not just from one country
 - Anonymous raters do not know the test taker


Find TOEFL® Testing Locations

Registering to Take the TOEFL® Test

- "Register Now" at the <u>TOEFLgoanywhere website</u>:
- The online profile allows you to:
 - Confirm the location and reporting time the day before the test
 - Add up to 4 universities to receive your scores (must be done at least 24 hours before the test)
 - View test scores available approximately 10 calendar days after the test
 - Register to take the test again or to reschedule an appointment
 - Order additional score reports
 - Update contact information (Note: name and date of birth CANNOT be updated)
 - Review profile history (test dates and scores, orders, payments, etc.)

TOEFL® Identification Requirements

- You MUST register using the same name that appears on their primary ID (usually passport)
- You MUST bring acceptable ID to the test center on test day
- Failure to do these two things will result in not being able to test or having your scores cancelled AND forfeiting your test fee
- Questions about ID must be submitted in advance to the Office of Testing Integrity at tsreturns@ets.org (i.e. test takers who are refugees)
- ID requirements are outlined on the TOEFL website for students: www.toeflgoanywhere.org and will also be included in the your profile for each test registration


TOEFL® Scores

- No passing or failing score
- Scores ready online in
 10 days
 - Notification sent by email
